Summary: To authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Quimby in the County of Cherokee effective July 1, 2009.

The use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax shall be changed in the City of Quimby effective July 1, 2009.

PROPOSED USES OF THE TAX:

If the change is approved, revenues from the sales and services tax are to be allocated as follows:

- 0% for property tax relief
- 75% for capital expenditures and repair
- 25% for Street, Water & Sewer improvements

CURRENT USES OF THE TAX:

Revenues from the sales and services tax are currently allocated as follows:

- 0% for property tax relief
- 100% Street, Water & Sewer improvements
